Our 2024 signature events continued to be a success this year (rain and shine) – providing fun for all and crucial funds supporting a variety of programs at The Elliot through The Mary and John Elliot Foundation!

Garden Party

On Thursday, May 30, 2024, we welcomed guests to the 7th Annual Garden Party at our new location, The Bedford Village Inn. The event raised over \$40,000 to help support new equipment for the Elliot Breast Health Center. The funds raised at the event will help bring a new advanced intraoperative tool to The Elliot Breast Health Center, which will help breast surgeons to remove tumors with higher precision and accuracy, reduce additional surgeries, and reduce the degree of tissue removal.

Walk for Hope

On June 9, 2024, we held our 6th Annual Walk for Hope at Southern New Hampshire University. Through participants' remarkable fundraising efforts and the community sponsors, nearly \$70,000 was raised to support patient programs at the Solinsky Center for Cancer Care at The Elliot. Teams came out with smiles on their faces despite the soggy conditions to show support for family, friends, and loved ones touched by cancer. Opening remarks were given by Dr. Brian Knab, Medical Director of Radiation Oncology, and Kelley Burgess, a grateful patient and cancer survivor, who shared her impactful experience with walkers.

Golf

The 25th Annual Elliot Golf Classic took place June 6th at Passaconaway Country Club in Litchfield. It was a cloudy overcast day on the course, but that didn't stop donors from having funraising just over \$86K to help support our many patient support programs, including Child Life, our Dementia Care program, and our food pantry program for patients in need. The Elliot Health System Fall-Fest Golf Tournament, was unfortunately canceled due to weather, but an alternative event was held at X-Golf in Bedford in November.

Gala

On Friday, October 18th over 350 guests gathered in festive themed attire at the DoubleTree in downtown Manchester at the Elliot Health System Safari Adventure Gala. More than \$275,000 was raised to support various patient-centered programs at The Elliot -Child Life, Dementia Care, and social need programs like our food pantries in our Ambulatory Practices and Cancer Center. Guests were inspired with impactful stories of care from both patients and staff, including 8 year old, Jack McKenna, who raised over \$1,700 for the Child Life department.

Delta Dental/Elliot Corporate 5K Road Race

Over 3,500 walkers and runners participated in this year's race on August 8th. In its 31st year, the race is the largest road race in New Hampshire and one of the largest 5K road races in New England! Employee teams from The Elliot showed their support and represented us well as the largest corporate team of runners at the race. The event raised over \$21,500 for patient programs at the Solinsky Center for Cancer Care at The Elliot.

Mark has set the bar for the caring spirit of a grateful patient. He was The Elliot's first community Covid-19 patient being admitted through our Emergency Department on March 17, 2020.

Upon his recovery, he started the NH COVID-19 Relief Fund, which not only supported COVID patients as they recovered from the worst effects of the disease, but also addressed the well-being needs of staff through the pandemic. As we have moved past the pandemic, Mark has created programs to honor and thank the staff, including a spring flower giveaway, wellness cart supports and food truck visits to the hospital.

Mark is now a dedicated volunteer at The Elliot, serves on the Board of the Mary & John Elliot Charitable Foundation, and a strong advocate for grateful patient giving.
