Garden Party

On Thursday, May 30, 2024, The Mary & John Elliot Charitable Foundation welcomed guests to the 7th Annual Garden Party at our new location, The Bedford Village Inn. The event raised over \$40,000 to help support new equipment for the Elliot Breast Health Center and featured remarks from Donna Lithgow, Director of Diagnostic Imaging, Dr. Lana Shikhman, Director of Breast Surgery, and Dr. Marina Feldman, Medical Director of Breast Imaging.

The funds raised at the event will help bring a new advanced intraoperative tool to The Elliot Breast Health Center. The Mozart System is a sophisticated 3D tool that allows a breast surgeon to remove a tumor with higher precision and accuracy, gaining clearer margins in the initial surgical procedure. The Mozart intraoperative assessment will reduce additional surgeries and reduce the degree of tissue removal at the time of the initial procedure.



Walk For Hope

On June 9, 2024, we held our 6th Annual Walk for Hope at Southern New Hampshire University. Through participants' remarkable fundraising efforts and the generosity of community sponsors, nearly \$70,000 was raised to support patient programs at The Solinsky Center for Cancer Care at The Elliot. Teams came together in the rain this year to walk and show support for our community and despite the very soggy conditions.

Opening remarks were given by Dr. Brian Knab, Medical Director of Radiation Oncology, and Kelley Burgess, a grateful patient and cancer survivor. Each speaker offered touching stories and insight into the cancer patient programs that receive funding from the Walk for Hope.

A special thank you to the volunteers, sponsors, and team captains whose tireless efforts and contributions were instrumental in the smooth execution of the event. Each step taken and each dollar raised during the Walk for Hope contribute directly to The Solinsky Center for Cancer Care at The Elliot and the well-being of the patients we serve. All of the proceeds from the race will fund programs and services at The Solinsky Center for Cancer Care, including nutrition assistance and programs, rehabilitation therapy, integrative medicine, and support programs for patients as they manage their journey with cancer.

The Elliot Celebrates 35 Years of Neonatology at Reunion with Families Across Southern NH

On Saturday, June 22, 2024 The Elliot welcomed more than 500 people to a reunion event at The Derryfield School in Manchester, NH to celebrate 35 years of neonatology and the Elliot's Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU). Families with children who were cared for in the Elliot NICU over the past five years, traveled from across southern New Hampshire to join the event.

The NICU reunion was an opportunity for families who have spent time in the The Elliot NICU to connect with others who share similar experiences, play games together, and reunite with neonatologists, nurses, and other NICU staff. Aidan Lamothe, who was born 12 weeks early in 2007, weighing just three pounds, welcomed guests, and said, "The NICU was my first home – and my parents were so grateful for the amazing care I received. Not only did the staff take care of me, but they supported my parents too, on every step of our roller coaster journey...The Elliot NICU makes miracles happen! Every day, tiny babies like me not just survive, but thrive – because of the dedication and expertise of this amazing team."

Elliot neonatologist Dr. Malgorzata Bulanowski welcomed families to the reunion saying, "Seeing so many of you here, happy and healthy, fills our hearts with immense joy and pride. Each of you has been through a unique and challenging journey and today is a testament to your courage, hope and unwavering love. Today, we celebrate the milestones achieved and look forward to the future filled with hope and happiness." Elliot Clinicians Reducing Unnecessary Sedation for Pediatric MRI Patients

For children, unfamiliar sights, sounds, and smells of a medical facility can be overwhelming, especially when they're not feeling well. MRIs, in particular, can be a source of anxiety.

A team of experts from Radiology, Child Life, IT, Anesthesia, and Elliot Pediatric Neurology Associates decided to change that. They challenged the traditional approach of sedating children before MRIs.

Pearl Manor Fund



The roots of the Pearl Manor Fund began in 1875 with a small group of 24 Manchester-area women who banded together to serve the needs of the greater community. They sought inclusivity – any woman could join the work of the Society for an annual fee of 50 cents.

The Women's Aid and Relief Society had a strong impact on the mill town of their day and created positive change in hundreds of lives. Their work evolved, as the community did, remaining committed to housing and nursing needs and transforming their buildings and services to match; from opening the area's first hospital to creating Pearl Manor.

The Pearl Manor Fund was established in 2005, when Women's Aid Home (Pearl Manor) assets were transferred to the Mary & John Elliot Charitable Foundation to steward the fund and to create the Pearl Manor Fund grant program. *(continued on next page)*

These funds are distributed by community volunteers through grants to not-for-profit agencies for new and expanded projects and programs to provide assistance, comfort, care and treatment for the senior (older adult) population of Manchester and surrounding communities including, but not limited to safe housing needs, nutritional needs, support groups, home visits, mentoring and social programs, independent living assistance, legal assistance, health care needs, and transportation assistance.

The 2024-2025 grant recipients are:

Amoskeag Health; Boys & Girls Club of Greater Manchester; Easter Seals NH; St. Joseph's Community Services/Meals on Wheels, The Solinsky Center for Cancer Care at The Elliot; The Mental Health Center of Greater Manchester; and Waypoint.

IMPACT FUND

This past year our team focused fundraising efforts on patient-centered programs – including our child life program, Dementia-Friendly Initiative, and the Food Pantry at The Solinsky Center for Cancer Care at The Elliot. Each program is designed with the patient in mind and how The Elliot can best serve the needs of our community.

Child Life

Child Life has played an important role in the hospital for our youngest patients. They make sure these children have emotional support during a very stressful time by helping them cope and improve their healthcare experience. One patient in particular, Jack Mckenna, decided his journey with Child Life didn't end once he left the hospital – it had just begun.

In January of 2023, Jack was healthy and had just celebrated his 8th birthday, but by spring, small changes in his behavior and eating habits raised some red flags. After many tests, Jack was admitted to Elliot Hospital, where it was determined that he had Crohn's Disease. Jack and his family were overwhelmed with information and grief but were carried by the support of their family, friends, and medical team. Upon discharge, Jack shared that he was "a little sad to leave." Can you imagine being treated so well at the hospital that you were sad to leave?



For the first anniversary of his diagnosis, Jack set a goal of donating \$500 to the Child Life department. Child Life provides support services to pediatric patients across the hospital and he was determined to see to it that other kids have the same great experience that he had while being sick. Within two weeks, Jack tripled his goal and raised over \$1,700! Since his diagnosis, Jack has turned 9, exceeded his school's talent show, and joined the Destination Imagination team. He spends his days playing basketball, riding his bike with friends, hiking, and doing things most 9-year-olds love to do.



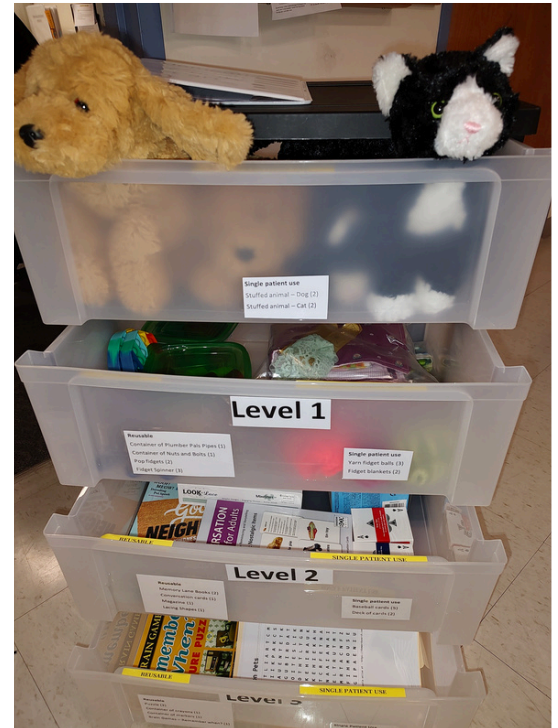
Jack attended the Elliot Health System Gala this past October with his family, where he was able to thank all his doctors and staff members of Child Life in person – advocating attendees on the importance of Child Life and how it impacted not only his life but his family.

Dementia Friendly Initiative

The Elliot Dementia-Friendly Initiative is committed to making patients living with dementia feel safe and comfortable during their hospital stay. Each floor is equipped with dementia care carts that nurses are trained to use. Each cart has items specific to the patient's needs, including stuffed animals, fidgets, coloring books, puzzles, and more. The realistic stuffed comfort pets can give patients positive feelings and security, when in the hospital, or unfamiliar surroundings. These pets have grown tremendously popular with patients over the past year. We've partnered with Douglas Toys which is based right out of New Hampshire.

Recently, a patient living with dementia was distraught during her stay because she missed her dog. A nurse presented one of the comfort pets to the patient who was visibly calmed upon receiving her stuffed dog. The patient was incredibly touched and wept, remarking how beautiful the dog was and how much she looked like her own dog.

Cancer Center Food Pantry



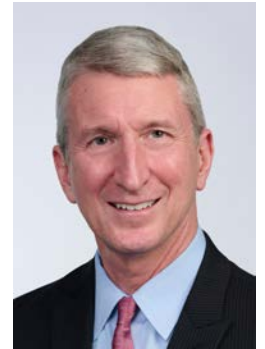

Artificial Intelligence is rapidly becoming an integral part of healthcare, providing solutions that enable physicians to work more efficiently and effectively. Many providers at Elliot Health System are now using the Dragon Ambient eXperience (DAX), an innovative AI tool that securely captures office visit interactions and converts them into notes. This technology lets providers engage fully with patients without the burden of real-time documentation, enabling them to focus on the patient instead of paperwork.

AI-powered tools are now capable of analyzing vast amounts of data, from medical images to electronic health records (EHR), with remarkable speed and accuracy while ensuring patient privacy. As Elliot Hospital continues to integrate AI into its healthcare delivery, the focus remains on improving patient outcomes and personalizing care.

Recently Dr. Holly Mintz represented The Elliot on the national stage at Microsoft headquarters in Redmond, WA. Dr. Mintz spoke to health AI developers from around the world at a summit that focused on the current and potential use of AI in the industry. In the spring, she also presented on a webinar hosted by Becker's Healthcare about access to behavioral health services, and innovation to improve access.

As Elliot Hospital continues to integrate AI into its healthcare delivery, the focus remains on improving patient outcomes and personalizing care. Dr. Mintz envisions a future where AI and human expertise work hand in hand: "The patient-provider relationship is always a priority. AI will never replace the human element in healthcare, but it will undoubtedly enhance it. By leveraging AI, we can make more informed decisions, spend more quality time with our patients, improve the quality of life of our providers, and ultimately provide better care."
